Almost two weeks ago Helene brought destruction to our doorstep. Trees fell, roads crumbled, houses were crushed and most tragically lives were lost. As we grieve the loss and give thanks for life we are continuing to give and go and serve and share.

Starting today we are distributing small propane heaters to individuals and families who do not have the capacity to heat their homes. We have ordered 300 heaters that will go to fire departments throughout the High Country. The timing couldn't be better since there was frost on the ground this morning.

This was the first person that received a heater. She is 78 years old, cleans the Cranberry Middle School and does not have power or water. This kind of heat will allow her to stay in her house and continue to work for the good of children and our county.

This was made possible by many of you who have given to Arbor Dale. As we move forward we will continue to assess needs and how we can play a part in meeting the needs people have so that we can flourish.
